

The MET Mark for North America

For North America and Canada, all hazardous location (Hazloc) equipment must be assessed and approved by a NRTL (Nationally Recognised Test Laboratory) before installation. To demonstrate compliance, manufacturers can have their product assessed and tested by Eurofins CML (a MET NRTL site), and upon completion display the MET mark. The MET mark enables customers, end users, and the Authorities Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) to confidently recognize that the product has been assessed and tested by a NRTL and has been verified as compliant against the applicable standards/requirements for North America and Canada.

An NRTL certification provides clear evidence that an electrical and electronic product complies with the required standards of the North American market, that your products are safe to use. This provides evidence that such products can be used in the workplace and that they will comply with the requirements of both OSHA and any relevant AHJ (Authority Having Jurisdiction).
